

FREE THE FENSUAGRO THREE!



Dear Ambassador,

I am writing to call for the release of three members of FENSUAGRO, the Colombian agricultural workers' trade union. Alexis Antonio Arroyo, Eulogio Tapiero Galindo, and Manuel Antonio Marquez were imprisoned on 22nd June. All are accused of "rebellion" and are being held in Mocoa Prison, Putumayo.

The case against them rests on the testimonies of supposed former guerrillas; unreliable evidence that is frequently used to fabricate false cases against trade unionists.

These are just three of around 75 members of FENSUAGRO, UNITE's sister union, currently detained in Colombia. We will not allow our colleagues to be silenced.

The Colombian government's practice of imprisoning trade unionists because of their work is unacceptable.

I urge the Colombian authorities to release these three and others like them without delay.
